MUSEUM HOURS

Daily, 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.
The Museum is closed on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day,
and New Year's Day.

GENERAL ADMISSION

Admission is \$27 for adults, \$21 for seniors, students,
teachers, and active or retired military with ID, and \$14 for
children ages 6 and up. Children ages 5 and under
are free. All tickets are valid for two consecutive days.
