- Ran Away

- Did Not Agree to Service
- Served for life
- Agreed to Service, Unless Sentenced as Punishment for a Crime
- Worked Long Hours at Difficult Tasks
- Declining During the Revolutionary Era
- Expected to Receive Land at End of Service
